If chosen as a contracted vendor: farmers will redeem benefits for participants of the Cherokee Nation WIC Farmers Market Program and ensure the produce offered is locally grown. Farmers must complete an application and be approved to become a vendor to redeem benefits. Cherokee Nation WIC is an equal opportunity provider.
